What are Graphic Organizers?

Operational Definition-

- ▶ "Graphic organizers are visual displays teachers use to organize information in a manner that makes the information easier to understand and learn" (Meyenj, Vergason, & Wheland, 1996)
- ▶ By providing an outline that is both linear and spatial in design an instructor is drawing from the three instructional senses of; Audio (lecture/coral response), Visual (Mnemonics/demonstration) and Kinesthetic (physical participation). This leads to better retention (Ruthkosky, K. & Dwyer, F. 1996)
- ▶ This provides the information in multi modalities for learners so there is higher chance of impacting the whole student body at one time.

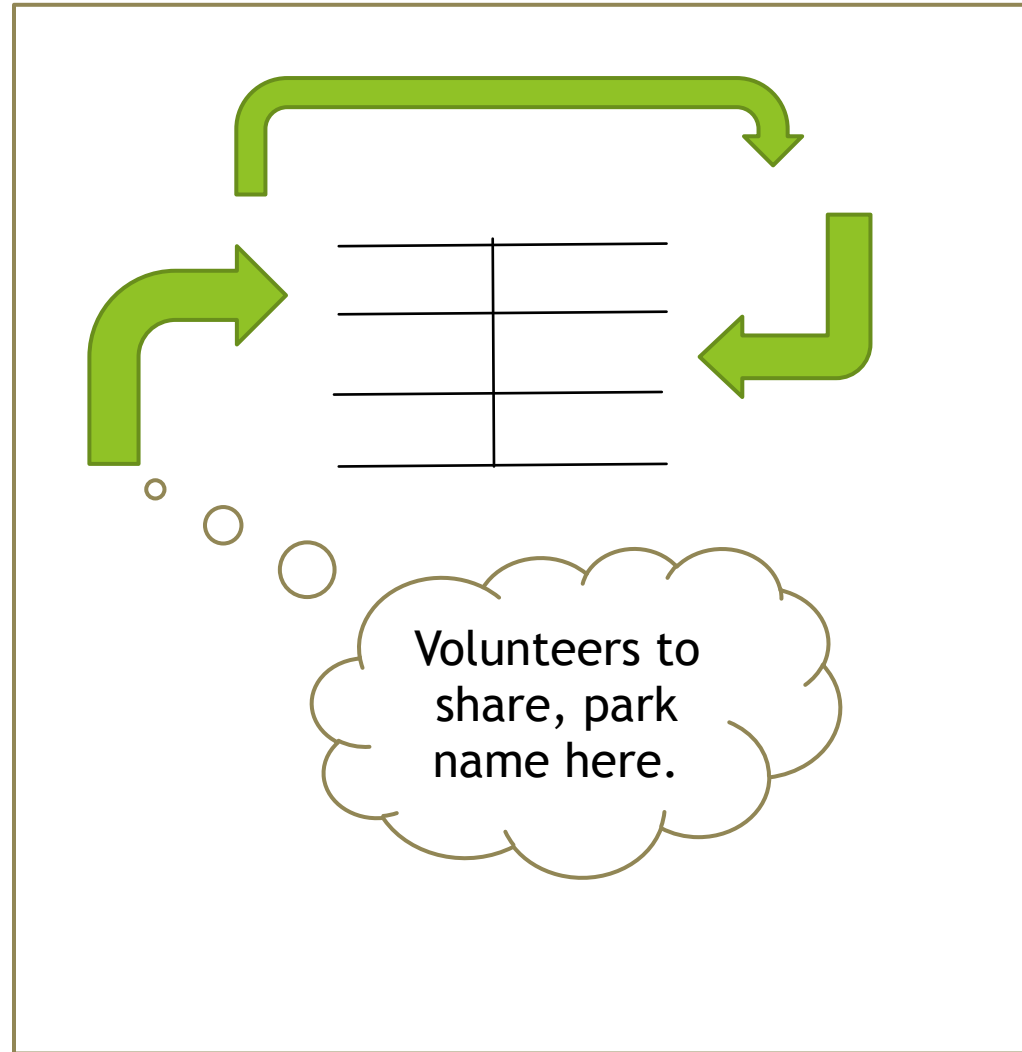
