### What are Graphic Organizers?

#### **Operational Definition-**

- "Graphic organizers are visual displays teachers use to organize information in a manner that makes the information easier to understand and learn" (Meyenj, Vergason, & Wheland, 1996)
- By providing an outline that is both <u>linear and spatial</u> in design an instructor is drawing from the three instructional senses of; <u>Audio</u> (lecture/coral response), Visual (Mnemonics/demonstration) and Kinesthetic (physical participation). This leads to better retention (Ruthkosky, K. & Dwyer, F. 1996)
- This provides the information in <u>multi modalities</u> for learners so there is higher chance of impacting the whole student body <u>at one time</u>.
