
#### Classroom Info

- 27 Active learning classrooms
- Whiteboards around the room
- Multiple displays in each room
- Flexible spaces with moveable mixed furniture types
- Seats range from 27 to 118
- Mix of small and large learning spaces
- Flexible and scalable technology



#### Rm 3001

- Seats 27
- Individual student moveable chairs
- 2 LED displays
- 2 Cameras
- 1 instructor location



#### Rm 2014

- Seats 118
- 60" half round tables & Steelcase Verb tables
- See Verb tables in Peterson with small whiteboards
- 7 LED displays
- 2 Cameras
- 3 instructor locations



#### Technology Overview


- ➤ Height-adjustable moveable instructor lectern
- ➤ Micro PC with DVD drive affixed to the desktop monitor
- > Articulating arm to increase available lectern surface area
- ➤ Ladibug document camera in every room
- Displays around the room (not 1 per table)




#### Technology Overview

- Wireless presentation at every display to accommodate group collaboration
- Audio enhancement for speech and recording
- Use of AV/IP technology to provide maximum flexibility in classroom systems
- > Technology centrally located in IT closets
- > All rooms equipped to support hybrid/blended learning

#### Instructor lectern





#### Audio Enhancement

- 1. Speech reinforcement: Each room has three microphones (gooseneck, lavaliere, and handheld) for the instructor
- 2. Hybrid/remote teaching: Ceiling mounted mics for the classroom
- 3. Large rooms: Additional mics to capture student reinforcement



### Centralized IT racks

- Most AV technology will be located in racks outside of the classroom
- Technology in the classroom will directly support teaching and learning needs



#### Hybrid/blended learning

- All rooms equipped to support hybrid/blended learning
- Each room has two cameras to offer flexibility communicating with remote users
- Each room has ceiling microphones strategically located to capture instructor and student discussion




#### Project Milestones

- Interior Finish Complete: January 5, 2020 (phased completion by floor)
  - Floor 1 Nov 20<sup>th</sup>
  - Floor 2 Nov 25<sup>th</sup>
  - Floor 3 Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>
  - Floor 4 Dec 24<sup>th</sup>
  - Floor 5 January 4<sup>th</sup>
  - Floor 6 January 5<sup>th</sup>
- Furniture Install: November 16, 2020 (start) January 16, 2021 (complete)
- Move-in (Phased): January 18, 2020 (start) February 2020 (complete)

#### **NEXT STEPS**

- Finalize the touch panel interface to provide intuitive control of the classroom environment
- Support open houses in partnership with the Stearns Center to introduce faculty to the new rooms
- Facilitate user training on new technologies
