Students submit drafts, engage in peer editing, and receive instructor feedback

Example "A" Student Rationale

Please note, bolded comments correspond with the categories assessed in the Rationale Rubric.
 For decades, obesity has been a significant health concern in the United States. According to
 Flegal et al. (2016), 37.7% of American adults are obese. In Fairfax County, Virginia, 21.8% of adults over age 20 were obese in 2013 (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention [CDC], 2013). While this number

is lower than the national average, the obesity rate in Fairfax County has been rising over recent years; in 2011, only 19.5% of adults were obese (CDC, 2013). According to previous community assessments,

such as the Fairfax Community Health Improvement Plan, obesity is a prominent health problem in the area. A survey administered by Inova Fairfax Hospital from November 2015 to January 2016 identified

that obesity is among the top three issues related to the community's health; approximately 24% of

participants stated that obesity was a priority concern in the area (Verité Healthcare Consulting, 2016).

This survey also revealed that 45.5% of respondents have been told by a health care professional that

Comment [d2]: Notice here the writer provided **national statistics** to illustrate the severity/significance of obesity

Notice how the writer followed **inverted triangle structure**

They started broad (national level, US) than transitioned to more specific geographic region (state then county level, VA and Fairfax)

Comment [d3]: Pay attention to how the writer described the **prevalence of the health problem in the specific community/geographic region** selected (Fairfax County, VA)

See how the writer provided justification for targeting Fairfax County, VA (rates are on the rise)

Comment [d4]: Notice here the writer described the **prevalence of the health problem in the specific community/geographic region** selected (identified as an area of concern)
